#### **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:**

(Wilton Manors, FL)- On March 07, 2016 shortly after 8:00 AM, the Wilton Manors Police Department (WMPD) responded to a delayed residential burglary that occurred in the 2700 block of NE 2 Avenue. The suspect entered the residence through an unlocked back door while the resident was asleep and took miscellaneous items from within the residence.

Upon Officers arrival the suspect had already left from the residence. Officers were able to obtain surveillance video from the resident. The video shows the suspect ringing the doorbell at the residence and attempting to open the front door. Through an investigation Detectives were able to identify the subject as twenty-two year old Christopher Jean Paul.

On April 06, 2016 Detectives from WMPD arrested Jean Paul who is currently being held at the Broward County Sheriff's Office Main Jail on multiple charges to include one count of Burglary occupied structure unarmed, one count of Grand Theft more than \$300 and less than \$5,000 and one count of Violation of Probation for Robbery with a non-deadly weapon.
